



## **Educational Scholarship Opportunity available at the University of South Florida for Fall 2009 and Spring 2010!**

**Scholarship:     **The John B. Allwein Scholarship for Military Veterans**  
\$2,000 total award (\$1,000 Fall, \$1,000 Spring)**

The John B. Allwein Scholarship for Military Veterans was established to aid students with physical service-related injuries return to school. Requirements include:

- Applicant must have experienced severe combat injury and disability as a result of military service in the Middle East within the last 5 years. Injuries must have caused severe disability:
  - Loss of limb(s)
  - Loss of eye(s)
  - Brain injury
  - Disfigurement
  - Other significant factors (severe burns, etc)
- At least half-time enrollment (6 USF credit hours undergraduate, 5 USF credit hours graduate)
- 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) – flexible dependent upon nature of injury.
- Priority for awarding the scholarship will be given to undergraduate or graduate USF St. Petersburg students who meet the scholarship criteria; if no USF St. Petersburg students who meet the scholarship criteria are identified, then undergraduate and graduate applicants from throughout the USF system who meet the scholarship criteria will be considered.
- 250-500 word type-written essay covering the following topic:  
Describe the nature of your injury and what personal challenges you have faced in order to return to school following your military service.
