Details: This is a sailing trip and previous boating experience is required. We will be spending three days and two nights aboard the large sailboats. Most meals will be provided, there will be many opportunities to go ashore. We plan on leaving the dock at 2:30pm Friday and returning to USFSP Sunday between 4pm and 8pm.

USF St. Petersburg is supplying the sailing instructors, sailboats and all related sailing equipment, as well as most snacks and meals.

Recommended items to pack in a small bag include: 3 tee shirts, 3 sets underwear, 2 pairs shorts, 1 pairs pants (sweat pants, running pants, wind pants, etc), 2 long sleeve shirts (fleece, hooded sweatshirt, etc), 2 swimsuits, shoes (1 pair), sandals (1 pair), jacket (windbreaker-waterproof preferred), towel, sunglasses/hat, sunscreen, hygiene items (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush—think travel sizes), sleeping bag/pillow, and a reusable water bottle.
